

# **HarrisX Overnight Poll Permanent Political 3.25.2024**

This survey was conducted online within the United States on March 25 among 1,010 registered voters by HarrisX. The sampling margin of error of this poll is plus or minus 3.1 percentage points. The results reflect a nationally representative sample of registered voters. Results were weighted for age, gender, region, race/ethnicity, income, political party, education, ideology and area type where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population.
