

HarrisX Overnight Poll State of the Union 3.11.2024

This survey was conducted online within the United States from March 8 - March 10 among 2,017 registered voters by HarrisX. The sampling margin of error of this poll is plus or minus 2.2 percentage points. The results reflect a nationally representative sample of registered voters. Results were weighted for age, gender, region, race/ethnicity, income, political party, education, ideology and area type where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population.
